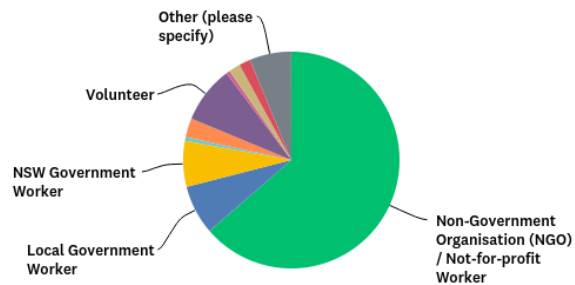


communityNet Evaluation Survey 2018

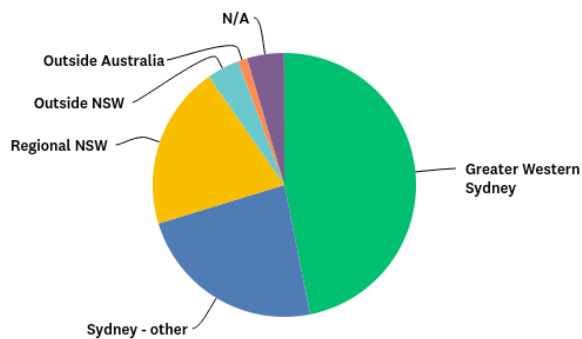
Number of responses: 177

Q1 What best describes you?



The percentage of survey respondents identifying as not-for-profit workers increased by 8%, while the percentage of those identifying as NSW Government Workers fell by 9%. Other percentages remain about the same.

Q2 Where do you work?



Consistent with 2015 evaluation results, almost half our audience work in Greater Western Sydney.

Top 3 benefits of communityNet

- 76% - Provides me with **information & resources** for me, my service and/or clients
- 67% - Increases my **networks and/or knowledge of services, initiatives and/or events** of interest
- 48% - **Saves me time** searching for information

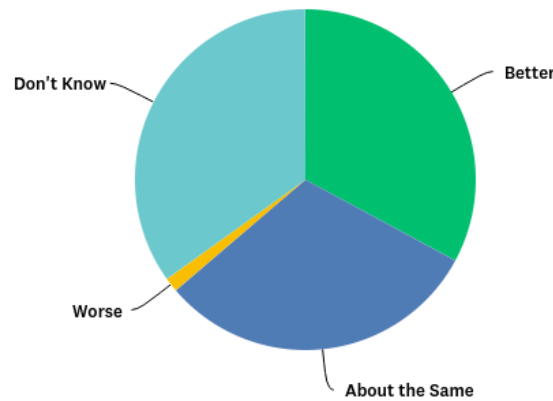
How did you first hear about communityNet?

Word of mouth/recommendation was the top answer at 37%, followed by web search at 13%. 26% didn't know or couldn't remember.

Subscribers

78% of survey respondents were communityNet e-News subscribers, followed by NCOSS e-News (34%) and Parramatta e-News (30%)

Q6 If you subscribe to other similar sector e-Newsletters e.g. HSNet, ProBono Australia, etc, how do you rate communityNet in comparison?

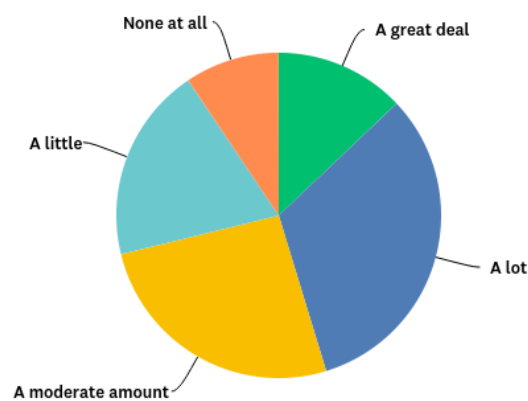


When rating communityNet as better, the reason most often cited was the localised nature of news and events (e.g. our geographically specific e-Newsletters).

Those citing the maximum negative impact commented on the amount of time they would have to spend searching for information themselves, and the lack of comparable sources of resources, news and events.
